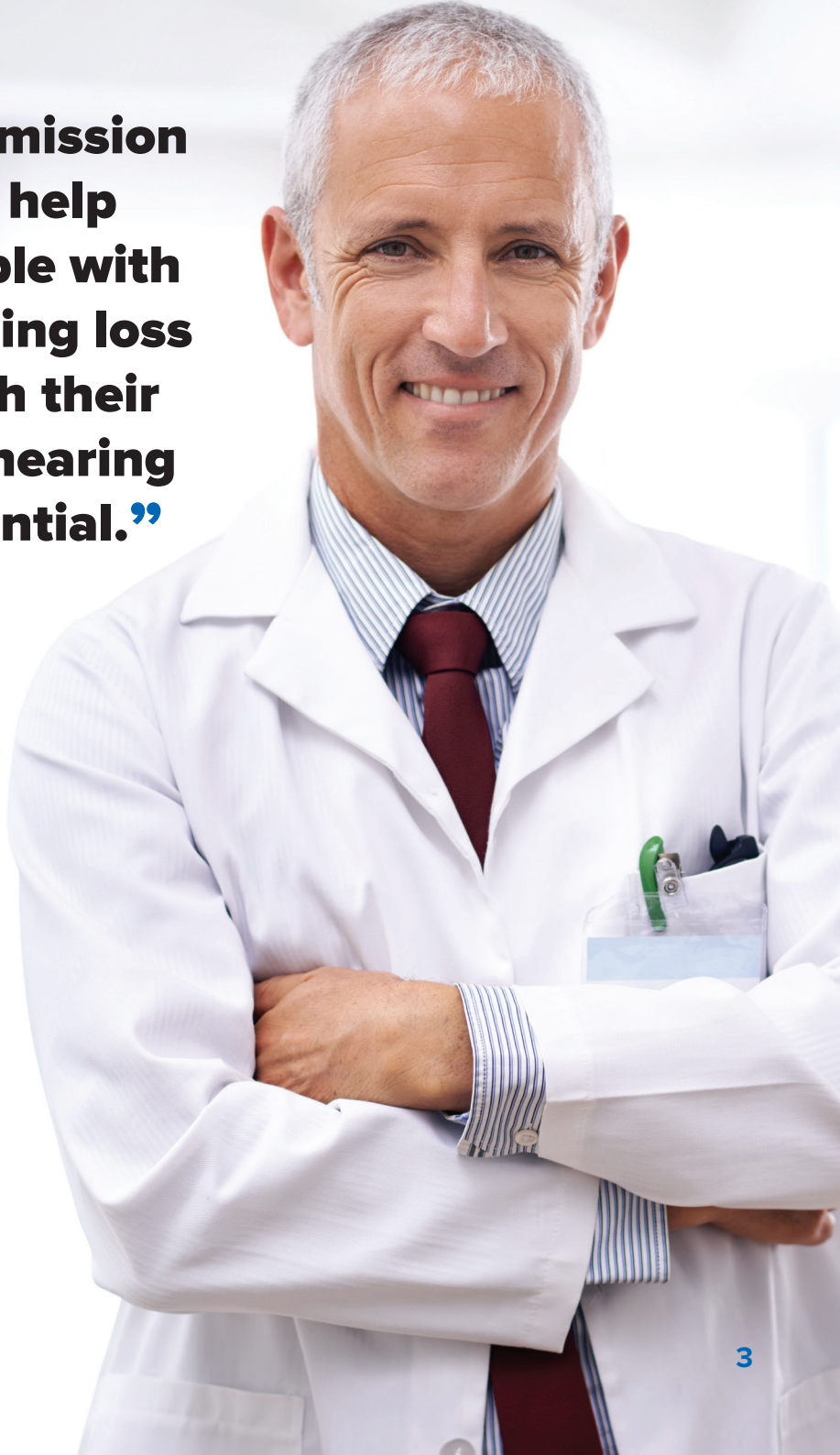

Free Hearing Tests

It costs nothing to call and the full consultation is absolutely free. If you decide to have a hearing assessment, we strongly recommend that you bring a family member with you for support and to help with the speech test which is part of the hearing assessment.

We have introduced the video otoscope, which is the latest screening technology at our hearing centres across the country. The video otoscope uses a tiny fibre-optic camera to see the condition of your ear and it even gives you a detailed photograph. Here at Hidden Hearing, we go the extra mile for our patients.

Grant Entitlements

The Treatment Benefit Scheme is a scheme run by the Department of Social Protection (DSP) that provides dental, optical and aural services to qualified people. The Aural Treatment Benefit Scheme is available to insured workers and retired people who have the required number of PRSI contributions. If you are an income tax payer, you may be able to claim the cost of your hearing device against tax (MED 1). Your hearing care professional will be happy to advise you on other sources of financial help that may be available. Hidden Hearing offers a 0% finance repayment plan. The Department of Social Protection also announced this year that the Treatment Benefit Scheme is now available to those who are self-employed.

Hearing contributes to personal safety, emotional well-being and independence. Through your hearing, you are able to communicate directly with others and experience the sounds in your environment.

It's no wonder that hearing loss can be a challenge! Studies have linked the effects of untreated hearing loss to many problems, including stress, depression, isolation, and even health issues. But thanks to major strides in the field of hearing care, there are solutions for you that can improve your life.



You are not alone

Hearing loss often occurs naturally as people get older. We commonly associate hearing loss with advancing age, but that is not the whole picture. Research by Hidden Hearing* shows that people are failing to acknowledge and treat hearing loss in large numbers.


Our findings were that 35% of people with hearing loss do not seek treatment at all, and 22% wait five years or more before seeking help. In Ireland, only 25% of those with hearing loss use hearing aids, whereas the global average is 51% and in the USA, Canada and Australia, 66% use hearing aids.

Because hearing loss can occur gradually, its effects are not always obvious. It's typically not easy to recognise a change in your own hearing, and often a friend or loved one points it out. At times, it's hard to believe that it's happening to you.

Taking care of your hearing is your responsibility. It's up to you to be alert to the signs and have your hearing checked if you suspect a change. People get their eyes tested and teeth checked regularly ...

Noise is dangerous if ...

- It's painful to your ears
- It makes your ears ring
- You have decreased or “muffled” hearing for several hours after exposure
- You have to shout over background noise to be heard

No matter what the cause, the real problem is often not the hearing loss itself, but that most people don't know they can do something about it.

Earwax Removal

Here at Hidden Hearing, we use 2 methods of earwax removal, irrigation & microsuction.

For most of us, noticing a change in our hearing can be concerning and at the very least annoying. In many cases, the issue will not be hearing loss related, but simply a build up of too much earwax, and if left untreated your hearing could suffer. It's actually good for your ears, helping to keep the skin healthy and helping prevent infection at the same time. Some people suffer from excessive earwax and this can be managed by use of drops, microsuction or irrigation. Wax can cause hearing loss and it can interfere with a hearing test or the use of a hearing aid.

Facts about Earwax in Ireland*

57% of sufferers self-medicate, according to the concerning results of a recent study.

Of these, 48% attempt to remove earwax by sticking earbuds into their ear canal, 7% use a hair clip while 60% opt to use ear drops.

11% mix these approaches and are unaware of the dangers associated with using earbuds and hair clips.

Earwax build-up is a widespread problem in Ireland which affects 60% of people. This means that 1 in 5 people regularly experience it and it can cause a multitude of unpleasant symptoms.

49% of sufferers say that earwax problems leave them with hearing loss and earache.

45% have perceived tinnitus symptoms - a buzzing or ringing sensation in the ear.

4% of people report a feeling of itchiness within their ears.

Causes of hearing loss

Close your eyes and concentrate. Listen to the sounds around you – the steady hum of a lawnmower, a car passing by or children playing outside. What you are experiencing are the “vibrations” of sound. The human ear is normally remarkably sensitive to a wide range of sounds. Sound vibrations are processed by the ears, the nervous system and the brain, becoming what we perceive as “sound signals.”

Our ears are very delicate and our ability to hear can diminish for a number of reasons. The majority of people develop hearing loss as they age. Over time, part of the ear’s delicate mechanism may break down or simply wear out.



Excessive noise exposure is the most common cause of hearing loss, and the most avoidable. Many work settings and recreational activities are quite noisy and can damage your inner ear. It is wise to avoid high volume levels in your car or when listening to a device with headphones. Wear earplugs in noisy work environments and to loud activities such as concerts. The more you do to protect your hearing now, the less likely there will be a problem later on.



How to tell if you have a hearing loss

Hearing loss can be gradual and sometimes difficult to notice at first. Hearing changes often do not result in an overall loss of volume. Some sounds remain audible as they always were, yet others become harder to hear, and some conversations require more attentiveness. You might notice that words just don't sound clear.

Many people with hearing loss find it especially difficult to hear certain sounds because their hearing loss affects a certain range of pitches. In typical hearing loss, softer, higher-pitched sounds become harder to hear, especially from a distance.

Speech has many quiet, rapidly changing high-pitched sounds. A lot of guesswork may be needed to understand the actual word if some of the speech sounds are not heard clearly. Conversations become more challenging when someone is speaking indirectly, or when there is background noise.



Ten warning signs of hearing loss

1. You require frequent repetition.
2. People seem to mumble or sound muffled.
3. You hear but have trouble understanding.
4. Background noise makes it hard to hear.
5. Phone conversations are difficult.
6. The TV volume is too loud.
7. You have difficulty following conversations of two or more people.
8. You don't hear the doorbell or phone ringing.
9. You have ringing in your ears.
10. You answer or respond inappropriately to conversations.

If you or a loved one have experienced two or more of these symptoms, there may be a hearing loss.



Awareness is key

Because people with hearing loss often do fairly well in quiet, face-to-face situations, signs of hearing loss often may not be obvious to your doctor. It's up to you to be alert to the signs and tell your doctor if you suspect that your hearing may be changing.

Next steps to better hearing

Your hearing care professional can advise you about the nature of your hearing loss and recommend the next steps. Fortunately, there are many ways to help people with hearing loss. **Only a very small percentage of hearing loss in adults can be improved with medication or surgery.** Hearing instruments can help most people. It is easy to try a hearing device in one of our clinics. Many clinics offer at-home trials. Wearing hearing instruments and treating your hearing loss can improve your quality of life and stave off other potential hearing loss-related health risks.

Your hearing consultation

Only a qualified hearing professional can tell you whether there is a hearing loss and recommend the best course of action. People experience relief when they learn the facts and gain a sense of control over their situation.

Schedule a visit with your hearing care professional. During your visit, a hearing assessment will be conducted and you will be informed of the results.

Your hearing care professional will discuss your hearing history to understand what factors have influenced your hearing, and also to get more information on your personal hearing needs.



Bring someone with you

Since the sense of hearing is of such importance, the decision to seek hearing help is very often a family event. Many hearing care professionals prefer that you bring a loved one, family member or friend to the visit. If hearing instruments are recommended, it is helpful to have someone present who would be involved in that decision process and to participate in the consultation.

Safety measures you can expect in the clinic when you attend for your appointment:

Before the audiometric test, you will observe the audiologist carrying out the below activities:

- Using hand sanitiser
- Cleaning all audiometric equipment with medical wipes
- Donning gloves
- Donning eye, nose, and mouth protection
- After the consultation is complete, the audiologist will discuss your results with you.

After the audiometric test, you will observe the audiologist carrying out the below activities:

- Cleaning all audiometric equipment with medical wipes
- Cleaning eye, nose, and mouth PPE with medical wipes
- Doffing gloves
- The audiologist will advise you of any 'next steps' to be followed.
